

Syringe Replacement Program (SRP)

As a public health intervention, the SRP provides new, sterile syringes to Persons Who Inject Drugs (PWID) for the primary purpose of preventing blood-borne disease (principally, HIV) transmission and acquisition among PWID, and indirectly, among their sexual partners.

Materials and Services

- Hypodermic Needles and syringes
- Personal Sharps Containers
- Safer Injection Supplies
- Wound Care Supplies
- Condoms and safer sex supplies
- Syringe collection and disposal for people who inject drugs
- NARCAN (Naloxone) overdose prevention kits.
