Hello VCHCC Members & Participants,

The results from the 2019 Community-Based Exercise survey are in! The winning **scenario for the 2019 community-based, Full-Scale Exercise (FSE) is EARTHQUAKE**.

During last month's VCHCC meeting, we provided the date of the Statewide Medical & Health Exercise (SWMHE) and informed participants that Earthquake was currently, the most voted upon scenario. Since the meeting, it has been brought to our attention that many of the VCHCC partners participate in the annual, Great California Shakeout. Therefore, we have elected to move the date of our community-based, FSE in Ventura County so that we may be in alignment with the date of the Great California Shakeout.

The new date for the Ventura County 2019 FSE is October 17, 2019.

We recognize that the change in date removes an entire month from our planning timeline and will take this into consideration as we design the exercise (i.e. structuring the planning processes with a mixture of web-based and in-person meetings and narrowing the scope of exercise components). We are hosting our Concept & Objectives meeting with our internal staff, next week. This meeting will officially begin the planning process for the FSE. We will provide you with the timeline for the exercise planning process and a link to the Intent to Participate (your way of letting us know that you will be participating in the exercise) on Friday, August 9th.

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
