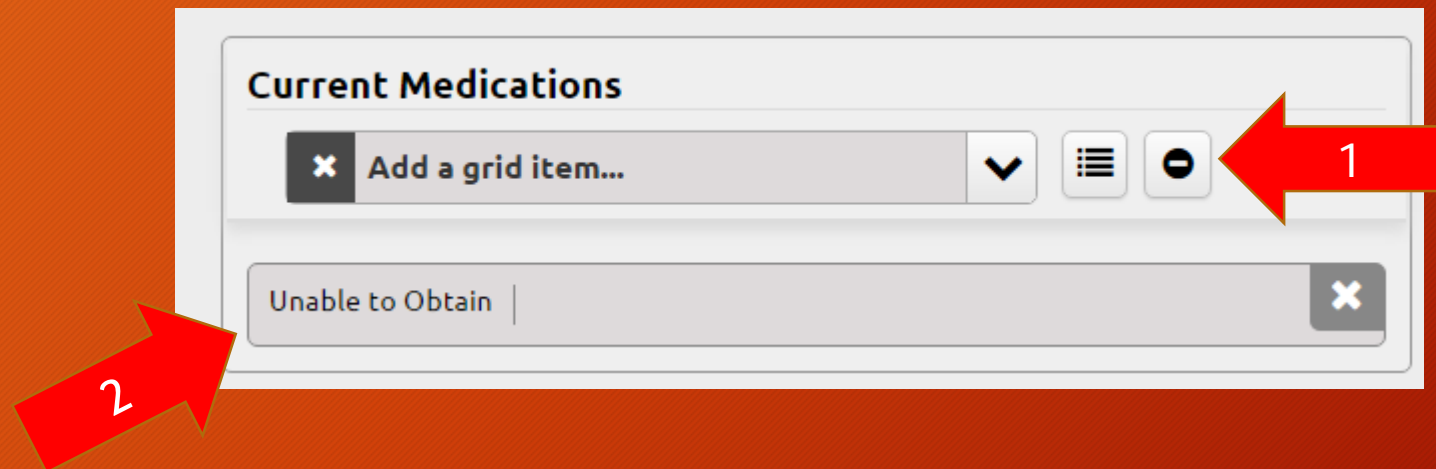

Activating Current Medication Comments

Step 1: Choose a medication value, Null Value, or Pertinent Negative

For the purposes of this user guide, we will use the Pertinent Negative "Unable to Obtain"

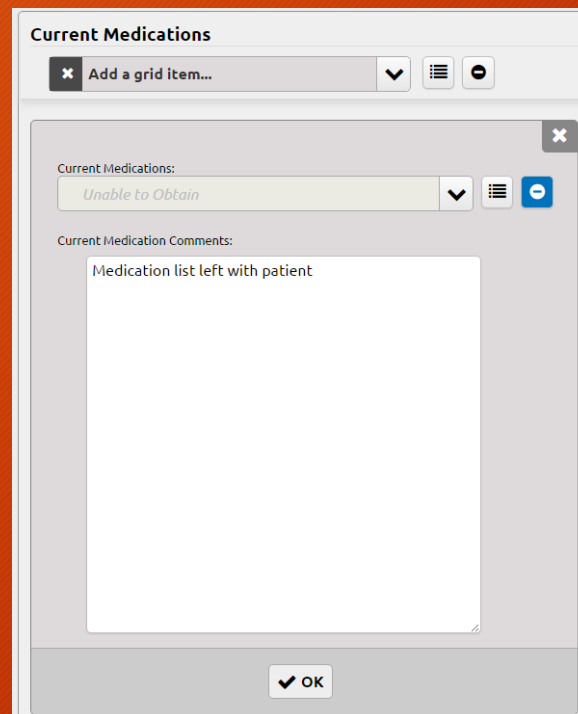


Step 2: Once selected, click on the value you just chose.

Adding Comments

Enter your comments, if any, and click OK to save

Note: If you choose a Null Value or Pertinent Negative, a medication comment is *required*.

Additional Considerations

- Entering in each medication through the appropriate Current Medications field is the preferred method of gathering this information.
 - There are obviously times where this is not feasible, or there is more information needed that what is available through the dropdown list.
- Medication comments should not be entered into the Narrative.
- Unless required due to a Null Value or Pertinent Negative, medication comments are optional.
